Cisco Announces Redesign of Associate-Level Certification Programs

On March 26, 2013, Cisco announced the redesign of the Cisco associate-level certification programs, including the Cisco CCENT and CCNA certifications. Cisco has evolved its associate-level certifications to align with changing industry job roles in routing and



switching, and advanced technologies such as security, wireless, voice. The certification formerly known as CCNA has evolved to a concentration and has been renamed CCNA Routing and Switching.

In addition, CCENT certification now becomes a foundational certification and replaces CCNA as the prerequisite for associate-level advanced technology certifications, including CCNA Security, CCNA Voice, CCNA Wireless, and CCNA SP Operations.
