

Preview Next Release of CCNA Routing and Switching Courses



The CCNA Routing and Switching courses targeted for release in August 2013; Routing and Switching Essentials and Routing Protocols, are now available for preview. Note that the following items are not available in the preview versions of the courses:

- Quizzes, exams, or supplemental materials
- · Translated content or screen reader capabilities
- Support from the NetAcad Global Support Desk (Please do not contact the Support Desk for issues you may encounter in the preview courses.)

These draft versions of the courses are provided to enable instructors to have an early look at the course content for planning purposes. Please do not create classroom materials from the draft preview courses, because the content is not final and may undergo significant changes prior to the general availability release of the courses in August.

Routing and Switching Essentials is the second course in the CCNA R&S recommended course flow, and Routing Protocols is the second course in the additional flow designed to support transition from CCNA Exploration. To access the preview versions of the courses:

1. Log in to Cisco NetSpace

- 3. In the Professional Development section in the middle of the page, click View Instructor Courses
- 4. Select CCNA R&S Preview: Routing and Switching Essentials or CCNA R&S Preview: Routing Protocols from the list of IPD courses.

End of Life for Translated Versions of IT Essentials 4.0 and 4.1

Cisco Networking Academy has announced the end-of-life dates for the translated versions of IT Essentials (ITE) 4.0 and 4.1. The endof-life dates for ITE versions 4.0 and 4.1 are as follows:

Language	Last Class Start Date	Last Class End Date
Arabic, French, Spanish	31-JULY-2013	31-JULY-2014
Russian	13-DEC-2013	13-DEC-2015
All other languages	13-DEC-2013	13-DEC-2014



Note that the Last Class End Date is also the last date to access course materials online and the last date to receive support for the curriculum. Academies currently teaching ITE versions 4.0 or 4.1 should migrate to the localized ITE 5.0 courses as quickly as possible to take advantage of the new enhancements and alignment to the current CompTIA A+ certification. The localized ITE 5.0 courses are targeted for release starting in August 2013:

Arabic	September - October 2013
Russian	October 2013
All other languages	Community driven
