### Ball State Student comes in 19th in NetRiders.

On December 6 the third round of the NetRiders Post-Secondary competition took place. Of the 84 round 3 competitors there were a total of 6 students from an ASCP academy, 3 of those being from Indiana. When the competition was finished and the scores were taken, Nicholas Burton, a Ball State Computer Technology student finished in 19th place overall. This competition brought together the most talented students across the US and Canada, and placement of one Indiana student in the top twenty is a major accomplishment. The top scoring student from the US was Gregory Herbster from DeVry University in New Jersey, and the second highest score was Huy Mai from South Mountain Community College in Arizona. The ASCP extends their congratulations to all the students in the ASCP who competed and commends all the hard work that went into their studies.
